

Athelas Therapeutic Riding Reopening Plan:

- All participants and their aids/guardians, volunteers, Athelas staff and Instructors must wear masks at all times during lessons.
- Hand sanitizer will be maintained outside the front door. All participants must apply hand sanitizer before entering the viewing room.
- Hand sanitizer will be maintained at the mounting block and the viewing room for instructors and volunteers to sanitize hands before and after each lesson.
- All Athelas helmets and tack will be sanitized after each use. No reins will be used by riders at this time.
- The bathroom will be disinfected and sanitized every day after Athelas has closed and will be checked periodically throughout the day to be cleaned, disinfected, and sanitized as needed.
- The viewing room will be wiped down with disinfectant (doors, handles, tables, light switches, etc.) after Athelas has closed each day.
- Only scheduled riders and necessary staff/guardians are allowed to attend lessons. **Absolutely no extra visitors!** Staff/guardians shall remain in their vehicle when able and are not allowed to wonder around the facility or enter the barn. Athelas staff will bring the rider back to their vehicle after the lesson has finished. If staff/guardian must keep eyes on their rider they may remain in the viewing room.
- All riders, staff/guardians, and volunteers will be required to complete and sign a Vista Entry Log prior to each lesson.
- Our Otsego County Safety Plan will be on file with Otsego County and we will have a copy in the Athelas office.
